

COST TO TAXPAYER

- → Risk Transfer: ATP subsidy in 2000 was €1.1m
- → Capital cost of fleet replacement: Est. €39m
- → Budget saving: at present \in 35m in 10 years
- → Contract: service levels and penalties
- → Much better service:
 - New, Modern, Adaptable buses
 - Reduced emissions
 - More routes, more frequencies
 - Same Fares
 - Better service for less cost

Accessible, clean and safe

THE FLEET - EMISSION

Emissions Reduced

→ 48% Hydrocarbons
→ 94% Particulate Matter

→ 70% Oxides of Nitrogen

→ 55% Carbon Monoxide



THE FLEET - SMALL BUSES

- → used for villages and park & ride
- more manoeuvrable and more economical
- → All new with Euro V engines
- → seating 27 standing 21

THE FLEET - STANDARD BUSES

Standard 12 metre buses (153)

- → Higher passenger capacity
- → 125 are New Euro V engine
- → 28 are refurbished and upgraded to Euro V engines
- → Seating 40 Standing 30

THE FLEET - ARTICULATED BUSES

Articulated buses (46)

- Busy services on main roads particularly from/to Airport/ Cirkewwa/Mgarr terminals and Sliema routes
- → Airport services with luggage space
- → Buses presently used in other cities
- → All refurbished to Euro V standard
- → Seating 49 Standing 60



THE FLEET

- → Air conditioning, CCTV system, fully accessible, detailed information on board, PA system
- → Average age throughout 10-year contract is 6.5 years (down from 35 years)
- → Number of bus seats up from
 13,900 to 20,500 passengers
- → Separation of drivers & passengers
- → Seats:
 - Accessible priority seats for persons with mobility impairment
 - Adequate leg room between seats



THE FLEET

Inside the bus

- → Announcement of next stop
- Electronic displays showing next stop and final destination
- → Contact details of operator for complaints
- → Signs in Maltese and English
- → No smoking signs
- ➔ first aid, fire extinguishers
- Tracking devices on all buses
 linked with operator and Authority

- → Increased frequencies 07:00 to 19:00 on weekdays and Saturdays







Night Services

Bus Stops

- → 850 in Malta/120 in Gozo
- → Arriva will pay €800,000 to replace all bus stop poles
- → TM will invest €120,000 in bus shelters

INFRASTRUCTURE

€7m IT System

Real time info to Authority:

- Bus position through GPS
- arrival time on each bus stop
- alert for all delays
- persons boarding each bus stop

Information to Passenger:

- full timetable for each route
- online journey planner with bus stops/times/fares
- sms query capability
- arrival time query capability

Maximum Waiting Time

INFRASTRUCTURE

Travel Information

- Information on routes and timetables
 at ALL 970 bus stops and all buses
- Detailed route maps on all main bus stops
- → Call centre provided by operator
- → Radio updates
- Destination and route number displays on the front, on the side, and on the back of each bus
- Leaflets, pocket size maps, regional maps, and other information on the services

FARES - LOCKED IN

- → Fares Locked in for 10 years except for Cola & direct taxes
- → No increases for fuel price movements, inflation and all other costs
- → Cola mechanism after year 3
- €2 per week increase in Cola =
 €0.003 increase in fare*

*assumed 1,000 employees and 35,000,000 tickets sold

FARES

How do you buy tickets?

- Range of ticket types including smart cards and paper tickets
- → Eventually, tickets sent to mobile
- Choice of purchasing tickets at time of travel or in advance
- → Vending machines, website, call centre, shops or staffed booths
- Option to buy from bus on most routes

Park & Ride - Floriana

- → Increase of 391 spaces to total of 1476 spaces
- → Same frequency of service
- → 7 day ticket for €10 including parking and return to Valletta for 2 persons
- → Car sharing cost of \in 1 per person per day



PARK & RIDE

Other Park & Rides

→ Pembroke (Luxol) – 577 spaces
→ Marsa – 312 spaces

Modern & Cost Effective PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE

STAFF

- → Full time employment c.920
- → Drivers: c.780
 - company responsible for drivers' discipline
 - drivers work maximum

9 hr/day, 56 hr/week, 90 hr/2 weeks



STAFF: DRIVER TRAINING

- → Recruit & train new drivers
- → Re-train/ provide 'refresher training' for existing drivers
- → Extensive customer services training for all employees
- \rightarrow Ongoing annual learning requirement thereafter
- \rightarrow Team of expert driver trainers to
 - train Maltese driver trainers
- → Training buses will be used during the mobilisation period
- → Bespoke set of driver training and support materials
- → Arriva will be introducing a full Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) programme
- \rightarrow Strict conditions on behaviour and appearance of drivers





TRANSPORT REFORM

Transport Reform process nearing the end

 \rightarrow A policy that has reformed transport in Malta in 3 years

→ Most difficult, ambitious and rewarding

→ Targets

• Modal shift

- Emission reduction
- Reduce cost for users
